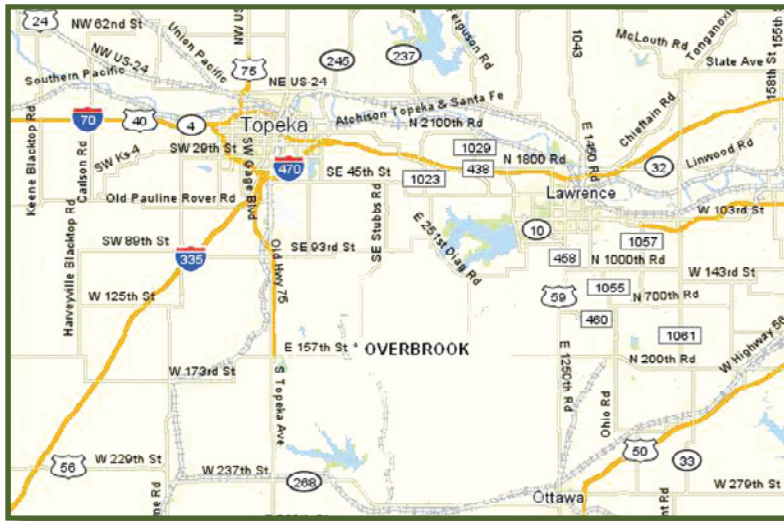


Overbrook is on the GO!

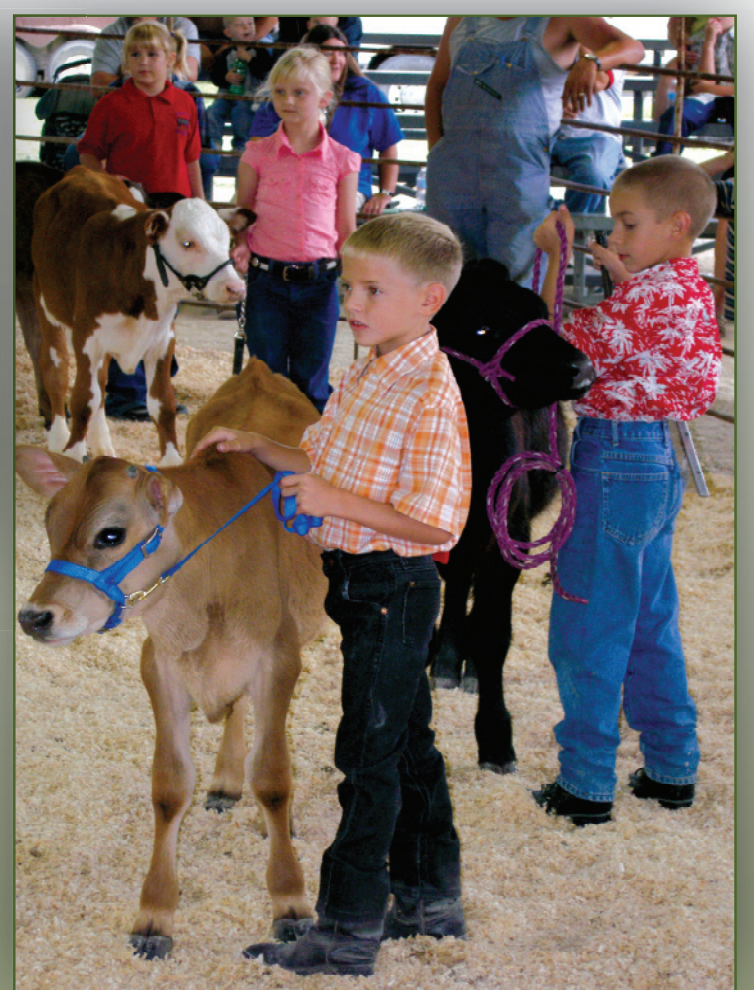
Improvements to the city’s infrastructure are ongoing, as the city moves to accommodate expansion in housing development and business.
